### 1.0 General Information

- 1.1 Purpose:** To provide a written, formal policy to ensure all students have access to curriculum and evaluation reference material.

- 2.1** Unless otherwise specified, the reference materials for the NFPA 1033 will be the FPOABC 1033 Manual with reference to NFPA 921. (The FPOABC 1033 Manual will be supplied to student at the time of registration)
- 2.2** Unless otherwise specified, the reference materials for the NFPA 1031 Level 1 will be the FPOABC 1031 Fire Inspection Manual. (Supplied to student at the time of registration)
